CODE OF CONDUCT FOR STUDENTS:

- The students must observe discipline. Indiscipline attracts punishment. They must observe self-imposed discipline in all activities, studies as well as other ones related to their stay in the College / Hostel.
- The students must be regular and punctual in their studies and maintain attendance as per the college rules
- Ragging is a crime. Student should not indulge in any form of ragging. Ragging is strictly prohibited in TKR College of Engineering and Technology. Any such act will be liable for punishment
- Students should behave, dress and project their image like dignified, respectable citizens of the Country.
- Their action must reflect respect for the faculty members and must inculcate a spirit of fellow- feeling and mutual respect among themselves.
- No student shall be discriminated on the basis of religion, caste, sex, gender etc.
- Students are expected to behave properly within the campus as well as outside when they represent the college. Any objectionable conduct if observed inside or outside the premises is liable for strict action against them.
- The students must not write on walls etc. or make undesirable sketches on the walls/furniture tops and doors etc.
- Damage to, or destruction of, property or actions that have the potential for such damage or destruction is prohibited.
- Actions which result in physical harm, have the potential for physically harming another person, which create circumstances that poses a threat of physical harm to another, or which cause reasonable fretfulness of physical harm are prohibited.
- Non-consensual sexual contact (or attempts to commit same), non-consensual sexual intercourse (or attempts to commit same), and/or sexual exploitation is prohibited.
- In order to become good engineers, student should observe professional ethics.
- Smoking and consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited in the campus.
