c. The Anti-Ragging Committeewill review the report and suggest suitable disciplinary action to the institute AntiRagging Committee for approval. Structure, Modalities and Functions of the Student Grievance Redressal Committee


Grievance:

Grievance is any dissatisfaction arising out of anything which a student or staff member feels unfair, unjust or inequitable.

Objectives

- To achieve a successful redressal of complaints from students and staff members with unbiased and equitable approach.
- 2. The objective of the redressal process is to ensure impartiality and consistency.
- To develop a culture of responsiveness and accountability among all stakeholders, with the aim of maintaining a calm and harmonious educational environment within the institution.
- 4. To maintaining the dignity of the college implies fostering a friendly relationship between students and teachers, as well as among the students themselves, in order to maintain a calm environment.

Grievance transmission Procedure

- 1. **Open door policy:** Complaints can be made by face-to-face approach or by telephone to the committee.
- 2. Grievance and Redressal committee boxes:Drop the Complaints and Redress Committee boxes in the department.
- 3. Email: Grievances can be sent to the email id of the Grievance and Redressal committee.

Complaints submitted anonymously will not be considered.

Grievance Redressal Procedure

Students

Functional:

- 1. When a student has a complaint, they should first speak with head of the Department either verbally or in writing. Head of the Department is expected to resolve the issue or address it within two days.
- 2. If the students complaint is not resolved or addressed within two days, and they remain dissatisfied, they may seek assistance from the GRC.
- 3. If the student's complaint remains unresolved or unaddressed by the GRC after seven days, they may escalate the issue by approaching the Ombudsman.

Non-Functional:

- When a student has a complaint, they should first speak with the convener of the concerned committee either verbally or in writing. The convener is expected to resolve the issue or address it within two days.
- If the student's complaint remains unresolved or unaddressed within two days, they
 may seek assistance from the GRC.
- If the student's complaint remains unresolved or unaddressed by the GRC after 7 days, they may escalate the issue by approaching the Ombudsman.



Functional:

- When a staff member ha a complaint, they should first speak with the Head of the Department either verbally or in writing. The Head of the Department is expected to resolve the issue or address it within 2 days.
- If the staff member is not satisfied or his/her complaint was not addressed within 2 days, He/she can approach he GRC.
- If the staff member is not satisfied or his/her complaint was not addressed within 7 days by GRC, He/she can approach the Ombudsman.

Non-Functional:

- A staff member should initially report their grievance either orally or in writing to the relevant committee convener. The convener is responsible for resolving the issue within two days.
- If the staff member is not content with the outcome or their complaint remains unresolved within the specified timeframe, they may escalate the matter to the GRC.
- 3. If the staff member is still dissatisfied with the resolution provided by the GRC within seven days, they may seek the assistance of the Ombudsman.

Role of Committee Members

- The committee member is expected to make a fair and impartial decision, taking into account only the evidence presented before them.
- To ensure a fair and impartial decision, no committee member should have a conflict of interest.
- There should be no ex parte communications and decisions should only be made based on the evidence presented during the hearing.
- If any member of the committee has a potential conflict of interest, they shoulddiscloseit during the meeting.

Conflicts of interest

A conflict of interest arises when an individual has a connection to one of the parties involved or possesses knowledge of the dispute that may impede their ability to make a decision based solely on the evidence presented at a hearing, free from personal interests or other influences. Committee members and the chairperson or president are expected to make impartial decisions, unaffected by personal interests, familiarity with the parties or witnesses, or other related circumstances. In the event that a member has a personal stake in the dispute, meaning that they stand to gain or lose something from the committee's decision, they should immediately step down from their position on the committee. Similarly, if a member has any prior knowledge or personal relationships that could sway their decision, they should also

recuse themselves. The critical question is whether the member can render an impartial judgment, irrespective of their knowledge or association with the parties. The chairperson may also request a member to withdraw from the proceedings if a conflict of interest is identified.

UNILATERAL DISCUSSION:

The committee is primarily responsible for making factual determinations and resolving the grievance solely based on the evidence presented during the hearing. Committee members are not permitted to gather their own evidence or engage in any communication with any party outside of the hearing regarding the grievance. The hearing should take place in a meeting where both parties have the opportunity to be present, or through correspondence between the committee and any party, which is typically managed by the chairperson with copies to all parties. If the committee believes that there is a witness who can provide relevant information regarding the grievance, the chairperson may propose to the parties that one or both parties call the witness to testify during the hearing in the presence of the parties or arrange for the testimony.







RolesandResponsibilitiesofAntiRaggingCommittees

1. Institute Anti Ragging Committee

- a. The institute aims to comply with the UGC regulation 2009 at all levels.
- The performance of the Anti-Ragging Squads in preventing ragging within the institution is monitored and supervised,
- c. If an incident of ragging is reported by the institute's Anti-Ragging Squad, necessary action is taken and the University Anti-Ragging Committee is informed. Approval for the proposed action is obtained before proceeding.

II. Anti-Raging Squad

- a. Surprise raids are conducted on academic blocks, hostels, and other areas where incidents of ragging are likely to occur.
- b. On-the-spot inquiries are conducted, and necessary

action is taken in response to any observed incident of ragging.

 c. The Anti-Ragging Squad maintains a register of surprise visits as a record.

III. Mentoring Cell

a. Senior Level

 To provide guidance and support, as well as facilitate interaction between freshers and junior level mentors

b. Junior Level

 To provide a congenial and welcoming environment on campus, while mentoring and interacting with freshers.

Action Procedure

a. The Anti-Ragging Squad must promptly investigate and report any observed instance of ragging or abetment of ragging to the head of the institute and the Anti-ragging Committee.

b. In case of a reported incident of ragging, the Institute Anti-Ragging Committee will take necessary action based on the severity of the situation.

This may include:

- 1. Immediatesuspensionofthe student involved.
- 2. Providingreinforcements orassistancesifrequired.
- 3. Forwardingthereportoftheincident totheAnti-RaggingCommitteeofthe Institute.

c. The Anti-Ragging Committeewill reviewthe report and suggest suitable disciplinary action to the Institute AntiRagging Committee for approval. However, reporting the matter to the civil police, district administration or filling a complaint/FIR will not be carried out without the endorsement of the Institute Anti-Ragging Committee.

In case of any reported incident, even if it is minor, the anti-ragging measures will be reviewed and strengthened immediately in addition to taking action regarding that incident.




