The implementation of remedial classes and Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) resulted in noticeable academic improvements. Pass percentages showed an upward trend, and CO-PO mapping was carried out more effectively, ensuring better alignment of course outcomes.

The IQAC conducted a comprehensive review and confirmed that the Plan of Action was being executed as intended, with all initiatives aligning well with the predefined objectives and contributing towards academic and institutional growth.

In response, the IQAC organized industry interaction programs, guest lectures, and internships to strengthen practical exposure and reduce the gap between academic learning and industry expectations.

4. Remedial Measures for Failures in Mid Examinations

To support students with lower performance in mid-examinations, the IQAC introduced targeted remedial measures. These included additional academic support through mentoring, along with special assignments and practice tests designed to enhance problem-solving abilities and overall subject understanding.

5. Analysis of previous semester results

The IQAC analyzed the first semester results and observed that the pass percentage was 64.55% for second year students ,68.85% for third-year students, and 85.97% for fourth-year students.

6. Review Result of Post Audit of Course Handout of Even Semester

Most course handouts met guidelines, though improvements were needed in CO-PO mapping, lesson planning, and updated references.



The IQAC reviewed the effectiveness of earlier remedial measures for mid-examination and end examination failures.


The review indicated that Remedial and bridge courses improved overall performance and pass rates, though some students continued to face challenges due to irregular practice and poor time management.
